THE NEW ROMAN MISSAL – Is the Catholic Church in Ireland alone in introducing this new Missal? The Catholic Church in Ireland, along with Churches throughout the English Speaking world, is working towards introducing the new edition of the Roman Missal at this time. This new edition is the English translation of the Latin Missal that was issued by Pope Paul II in 2002. Since 2002 the Church in its many languages has engaged in the work of the translating this Latin text through study, reflection and consultation. This work in English-speaking countries is now complete. In Ireland, as in other English-speaking countries, the new Missal will come into use on the First Sunday of Advent, Nov 27th 2011.
