<u>CONFESSION</u> is an integral part of our Christian Faith. We acknowledge our need for God's mercy and grace in our lives. On the <u>First Sunday</u> of each month, there will be an opportunity to avail of the <u>Sacrament of Reconciliation</u> before the Sunday Mass at 10.30 in the Quiet Room in St. Mary's Church. You are encouraged to avail of this opportunity and to develop a habit of regular confession.

<u>A NEW ROMAN MISSAL</u> will be introduced in all English speaking Catholic countries throughout the world from the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of Advent this year (November 27<sup>th</sup>, 2011). A Congregational Card will be issued by the Diocese before that date, to help us familiarise ourselves with the changes in the liturgy (the Mass prayers and responses). The missalette that we use at mass will introduce these changes from September 11<sup>th</sup> of this year (ie the 24<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time). While the changes in the Mass are small – they are nonetheless very significant, as we try to be more faithful to the original Latin text. The changes are as follows:

Opening Greeting of the Mass, Penitential Rite (Confiteor), The Gloria, Apostles Creed, Dialogue before Preface of Eucharistic Prayer, Holy Holy, Proclamation of the Mystery of Faith, Sign of Peace, Invitation to Holy Communion and Final Dismissal.

Short Explanation leaflets on these changes are available at the back of the Church and you are encouraged to take one home and familiarise yourself with the upcoming changes.

<u>THE MEDICAL MISSIONARIES OF MARY</u> will speak at all Masses this weekend about their work in developing nations. Presently there are 400 women from 16 different Nationalities working in 13 different countries throughout the world.
