These are men and women like us, brothers seeking a life (They are) hungry, persecuted, injured, exploited, victims of war. They are seeking a better life, they are seeking happiness. It is evident that the proportions of the phenomenon demand much greater involvement. We must not tire in our attempts to solicit a more extensive response at the European and international level".
